

Each proposed policy has a short-term impact and a long-term impact. No proposed policy will be perfect; in many circumstances, you may have to agree to some less-favorable terms in order to gain the large impact you're hoping for. In situations like these, it is helpful to ask: *is the negative I need to agree to worth the positive?* The answer to this question can vary widely depending on the proposed legislation or candidate; hopefully, this worksheet can walk you through feeling comfortable with what you're voting for and why you're voting for it.

- 1. What does the policy actually do? What doesn't it do?
- 2. What are the parameters of the proposal? (Where does authority stop and start?)
- 3. Who has the authority to enact the proposal, and do I trust them to act in my best interest?
- 4. Does the proposal consider the safety of myself, my family, my friends, and my neighbors?
- 5. What is the cost? (Both economic and human?)
